**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A3(M) Motorway (Junction 3, Northbound Exit Slip Road)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009**

*Made* - - - - *12th October 2009*

*Coming into force* - - *17th October 2009*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3(M) Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3(M) Motorway (Junction 3, Northbound Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 17th October 2009.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the A3(M) Motorway near Havant in the County of Hampshire;

“the slip road” means the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the motorway to the B2150 (Hulbert Road) at Junction 3;

“works” mean anti-skid surfacing, lining, signage and all associated work on the motorway; and

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 19th October 2009 or on any subsequent day until 16th April 2011.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
