**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A11 Trunk Road (Chalk Farm to Thetford, Suffolk)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009**

*Made* - - - - 12 October 2009  
*Coming into force* - - 19 October 2009

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A11 Trunk Road (“the A11”) is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the District of Forest Heath in the County of Suffolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A11 Trunk Road (Chalk Farm to Thetford, Suffolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 19 October 2009.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A11 between their junctions with the B1112 Icklingham/Eriswell and the B1106 Bury Bottom;

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the sign is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“works” mean resurfacing and associated works to the A11;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 26 October 2009 and ending when the said works have been completed;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 26 October 2009 or on any subsequent day until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter a lay-by adjacent to either carriageway of the trunk road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.

6. Nothing in articles 3 and 4 shall apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used in connection with the said works or for traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,
- (c) proceeding at the direction or with the permission of a police officer or traffic officer in uniform, or
- (d) requiring access to or from premises which are accessible from, and only from, that trunk road.
