ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A27 Trunk Road (Nyton Road)
(Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009**

Made - - - - *12th October 2009*

Coming into force - - *17th October 2009*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted and prohibited on lengths of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Nyton Road) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 17th October 2009.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A27 Trunk Road east of Chichester in the County of West Sussex;

“the westbound carriageway” means the westbound carriageway of the trunk road from a point 210 metres east of the centreline of Norton Lane to a point 110 metres west of the centreline of Nyton Road (B2233);

“the eastbound carriageway” means the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road from a point 50 metres west of the centreline of East Hampnett Lane to a point 100 metres east of the centreline of Nyton Road (B2233);

“central reservation” means that part of the trunk road which separates its carriageways for the safety and guidance of vehicular traffic using that road;

“the gap in the central reservation” means the gap in the central reservation of the trunk road opposite its junction with Nyton Road (B2233);

“works” means road marking renewal work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 19th October 2009 or on any subsequent day until 16th April 2011.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the gap in the central reservation.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the westbound carriageway or the eastbound carriageway.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6.—(1) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.

(2) Nothing in article 4 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
