**The M271 Motorway
(M27 Junction 3 – Romsey Road Roundabout)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009**

Made - - - - *12th October 2009*

Coming into force - - *17th October 2009*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M271 Motorway, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on lengths of that motorway because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M271 Motorway (M27 Junction 3 – Romsey Road Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 17th October 2009.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M271 Motorway near Southampton in the County of Hampshire;

“the length of northbound carriageway” means the northbound carriageway of the motorway between the roundabout at M27 Junction 3 (Nursling Interchange) and Romsey Road roundabout (A3057);

“the length of southbound carriageway” means the southbound carriageway of the motorway between Romsey Road roundabout (A3057) and the roundabout at M27 Junction 3 (Nursling Interchange);

“works” mean the installation and repair of traffic detection equipment and associated work on the motorway; and

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Thursday 22nd October 2009 or on any subsequent day until 16th April 2011.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of northbound carriageway or the length of southbound carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

(a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
