ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M4 Motorway (Junction 17 – Junction 18) (Temporary
Restriction of Traffic) Order 2009**

Made - - - - 14 October 2009

Coming into force - - 17 October 2009

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M4 Motorway (“the M4”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Junction 17 and Junction 18 in South Gloucestershire and Wiltshire should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M4 Motorway (Junction 17 – Junction 18) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 17 October 2009.

2. In this Order –

“the M4” means the westbound carriageway of the M4 from a point at the centre of the B4039 overbridge to the tip of the nosing of M4 Junction 18 entry slip road;

“tip of the nosing” means the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a motorway or the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of a motorway;

“the works” mean the installation of traffic counter loops works;

“the hard shoulder” means the hard shoulder within the meaning of regulation 3(1)(e) of the Regulations which is adjacent to the M4;

“the Regulations” mean the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982(b);

“a works period” means a period of 9 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Tuesday 20 October 2009 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the M4 and the hard shoulder.

4. The provisions of articles 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform.

5. During the works period, regulation 5 and (insofar as it relates to a vehicle being driven) regulation 9 of the Regulations are hereby suspended, in respect of the hard shoulder, at such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
