ROAD TRAFFIC

The A69 Trunk Road (West Denton Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009

Made - - - - *19 October 2009*

Coming into force - - *1 November 2009*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A69 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of Newcastle, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway maintenance, strengthening and resurfacing works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A69 Trunk Road (West Denton Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 1 November 2009.

2. In this Order “the works period” means a period of:

- (i) 5 hours starting at 19:00 hours on Monday 2 November 2009 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed; and
- (ii) 8 hours starting at 09:00 hours on Sunday 8 November 2009 or any subsequent Sunday thereafter until the said works have been completed.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A69 Trunk Road eastbound and westbound exit and entry slip roads at the B6528 West Denton Interchange.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform.
