ROAD TRAFFIC

The A12 Trunk Road (Harfrey’s Road Roundabout to Vauxhall Roundabout, Great Yarmouth, Norfolk) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009

Made - - - - *19 October 2009*
Coming into force - - *26 October 2009*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road (“the A12”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the District of Great Yarmouth in the County of Norfolk should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Harfrey’s Road Roundabout to Vauxhall Roundabout, Great Yarmouth, Norfolk) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 26 October 2009.

2. In this Order –

“the first length of trunk road” means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A12 between points 780 metres south-east and 750 metres north of their junctions with the Gapton Hall Road/Pasteur Road Roundabout;

“the second length of trunk road” means the A12 northbound and southbound carriageways between their junctions with Harfrey’s Roundabout and Vauxhall Roundabout;

“the works” mean congestion improvement works at Gapton Hall Road/Pasteur Road Roundabout to include the installation of partial signalisation and the up-grading of the existing Puffin Crossing to a Toucan Crossing;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 2 November 2009 and ending when the said works have been completed;

“a works period” means a period of 9 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 2 November 2009 or on any subsequent day until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 no person shall, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the first length of trunk road at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of trunk road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.

6. Nothing in –

- (a) article 4 shall apply to any vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works or for traffic office or winter service maintenance purposes, and
- (b) articles 3 and 4 shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes.
