**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M4 Motorway (Junction 13)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009**

*Made* - - - - *19th October 2009*

*Coming into force* - - *24th October 2009*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M4 Motorway, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that motorway because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M4 Motorway (Junction 13) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 24th October 2009.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M4 Motorway at Junction 13 in the District of West Berkshire;

“the length of motorway” means both carriageways of the motorway between the slip roads leading to and the slip roads leading from the A34 at Junction 13 at Chieveley Interchange;

“works” means the installation of traffic detection equipment and associated work on the motorway; and

“a works period” means a period of 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 26th October 2009 or on any subsequent day until 23rd April 2011.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
