ROAD TRAFFIC

The A500 Trunk Road (Talke Interchange to Tunstall Interchange, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009

Made - - - - *16 October 2009*
Coming into force - - *23 October 2009*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A500 Trunk Road (“the A500”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads between Talke and Tunstall in the County of Staffordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A500 Trunk Road (Talke Interchange to Tunstall Interchange, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 23 October 2009.

2. In this Order –

“the works period” means the period starting at 2000 hours on Monday 26 October 2009 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in –

- (a) the southbound carriageway of A500 between its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A34 (Talke Interchange) and its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the A527 (Tunstall Interchange); and
- (b) the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A500 from Talke Interchange.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable in uniform;
or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
