ROAD TRAFFIC

The A585 Trunk Road (Thornton Roundabout to Norcross Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2009

Made - - - - *21 October 2009*

Coming into force - - *25 October 2009*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A585 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that trunk road in the Borough of Wyre in the County of Lancashire should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A585 Trunk Road (Thornton Roundabout to Norcross Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 25 October 2009.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A585 Trunk Road;

“the length of carriageway” means the trunk road from the point where the centre point of the trunk road meets the circulatory carriageway of the Thornton Roundabout to the point where the centre point of the trunk road meets the circulatory carriageway of the Norcross roundabout;

“the works period” means periods daily between 0930 hours and 1600 hours starting on Monday 26 October 2009 and ending on Sunday 20 December 2009. However work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent days or continue until completed.

“works” means the construction of a new footway and associated works;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 6 of this Order no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of carriageway.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 6 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the second length of carriageway at a speed

exceeding 10 miles per hour whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.

5. Subject as mentioned in article 6 of this Order, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to overtake a moving vehicle or make a 'U' turn in the length of carriageway.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform.

And nothing in article 5 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works or by traffic officers.
