**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A63 Trunk Road (Mytongate Gyratory to Queen Street Junction)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009**

*Made* - - - - - *26 October 2009*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *8 November 2009*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A63 Trunk Road, in the District of Kingston upon Hull, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be prohibited because resurfacing, lining and pedestrian crossing renewal works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A63 Trunk Road (Mytongate Gyratory to Queen Street Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 8 November 2009.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 9 November 2009 or any subsequent Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday or Saturday night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A63 Trunk Road:

- (i) eastbound carriageway between its junction with Waterhouse Lane and its junction with Princes Dock Street, a distance of 260 metres; and
- (ii) westbound carriageway between its junction with Queen Street and its junction with the A1079 Mytongate Gyratory, a distance of 610 metres.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 2 shall apply to any vehicle proceeding in the A63 to or from premises and property which is accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
