ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Westbound Carriageway between Dordon Roundabout and M42 Junction 10, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009

Made - - - - - *9 October 2009*

Coming into force - - - - - *16 October 2009*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”) is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Dordon in the County of Warwickshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Westbound Carriageway between Dordon Roundabout and M42 Junction 10, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 16 October 2009.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the westbound carriageway of the A5 from its roundabout junction with Long Street and Gypsy Lane, known as Dordon Roundabout, to its roundabout junction with the M42 at Junction 10;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 19 October 2009 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable in uniform; or

(c) being used for or in connection with the said works.
