ROAD TRAFFIC

The A45 Trunk Road (Stretton-on-Dunsmore to Ryton-on-Dunsmore) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (No. 2) Order 2009

Made - - - - 9 October 2009
Coming into force - - 16 October 2009

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”) is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road between Stretton-on-Dunsmore and Ryton-on-Dunsmore in the County of Warwickshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Stretton-on-Dunsmore to Ryton-on-Dunsmore) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 16 October 2009.

2. In this Order –

| “Memorial Island” | means the circulatory carriageway of the A45 at its roundabout junction with the B4455 at Stretton-on-Dunsmore; |
| “Ryton Island” | means the circulatory carriageway of the A45 at its roundabout junction with the A445 and Wolston Lane, east of Ryton-on-Dunsmore; |
| “the first length of trunk road” | means the A45 from a point 1500 metres east of the centre point of Memorial Island to a point 1500 metres west of the centre point of Ryton Island; |
| “the second length of trunk road” | means –

roundabout junction with the A423 and Memorial Island;

“the third length of trunk road” means the A45 between Memorial Island and Ryton Island;

“a layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the sign is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

“the works period” means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 19 October 2009 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the first length of trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of trunk road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in -

(a) the westbound carriageway of the third length of trunk road; or

(b) the offside lane of the eastbound carriageway of the third length of trunk road in any direction other than westwards.

6. Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in -

(a) the eastbound carriageway of the third length of trunk road; or

(b) the offside lane of the westbound carriageway of the third length of trunk road in any direction other than eastwards.

7. Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any layby adjacent to the westbound carriageway of the third length of trunk road.

8. Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave –

(a) the westbound carriageway of the A45 at its junction with School Lane;

(b) the westbound carriageway of the A45 at its junction with Freeboard Lane; and

(c) the eastbound carriageway of the A45 at its junction with Stretton Road.

9. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

10. The provisions of:

(a) articles 3, 4, 5(a), 6(a), 7 and 8 shall not apply to any vehicle -

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform;

(b) articles 4, 5(a), 6(a), 7 and 8 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works; and

(c) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle proceeding in the second length of trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
