**The A14 Trunk Road (Junction 20, Ellington,
Cambridgeshire) Westbound Entry Slip Road (Temporary
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009**

Made - - - - 2 November 2009

Coming into force - - 9 November 2009

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road (“the A14”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the District of Huntingdon in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Junction 20, Ellington, Cambridgeshire) Westbound Entry Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 9 November 2009.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A14 westbound entry slip road leading from High Street, Ellington (Junction 20), during a period of 9 ½ hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 16 November 2009 or on any subsequent day until the gulley jetting works to the slip road have been completed.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a police officer or traffic officer in uniform.
