ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A19 Trunk Road (Layby at Billingham)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009**

Made - - - - - *4 November 2009*

Coming into force - - - - - *8 November 2009*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A19 Trunk Road, in the District of Stockton on Tees, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be prohibited because traffic sign installation works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A19 Trunk Road (Layby at Billingham) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 8 November 2009.

2. In this Order; -

“the layby” means an area of carriageway situated adjacent to the A19 Trunk Road northbound carriageway approximately 1400 metres south of Sandy Lane West overbridge, at Billingham, intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the sign is placed; and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 9 November 2009 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or wait in the layby.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform.
