## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The M27 Motorway (Junction 12, Westbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009

Made - - - - 9th November 2009

Coming into force - - 14th November 2009

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M27 Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that motorway and on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M27 Motorway (Junction 12, Westbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 14th November 2009.

## 2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M27 Motorway in the City of Portsmouth in the County of Hampshire;

"the length of westbound carriageway" means the westbound carriageway of the motorway from the slip road leading to Portsbridge roundabout (A3/A27) east of Junction 12 to its junction with the M275 at Junction 12;

"the link road" means the road leading from the westbound carriageway of the motorway to the southbound carriageway of the M275 at Junction 12;

"works" mean bridge, carriageway, cyclic maintenance and gantry work on the motorway; and "a works period" means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 16th November 2009 or on any subsequent day until 13th May 2011.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of westbound carriageway or the link road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
  - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;

- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
