The A12 Trunk Road (Breydon Bridge, Great Yarmouth, Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2009

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road (the A12), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the District of Great Yarmouth in the in the County of Norfolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Breydon Bridge, Great Yarmouth, Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 16 November 2009.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in articles 3 and 4 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 8 hours commencing at 20:00 hours on Monday 23 November 2009 or on any subsequent day until the testing of new cylinder installation and set up work to Breydon Bridge is completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A12 between its junctions with the A12/A47 Acle New Road roundabout and the A12/A1243 Gapton Hall/Pasteur Road roundabout, Great Yarmouth.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.
 - 4. Nothing in article 3 of this Order shall apply to a vehicle -
 - (a) being used in connection with the routine maintenance works or for traffic officer purposes,
 - (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,
 - (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a police officer or traffic officer in uniform, or
 - (d) proceeding to or from properties which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, the length of the trunk road described in article 2 above.
- **5.** During a period of 8 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 23 November 2009 or on any subsequent day until the testing of new cylinder installation and set up work to Breydon Bridge is
