## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A45 Trunk Road (Ryton-on-Dunsmore, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009

Made - - - - 23 November 2009 Coming into force - - 30 November 2009

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road ("the A45") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and two of those connecting roads at Ryton-on-Dunsmore in the County of Warwickshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Ryton-on-Dunsmore, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 30 November 2009.

## 2. In this Order -

"the trunk road" means the westbound carriageway of the A45 between

points 1378 metres and 1728 metres west of its junction

with High Street;

"a slip road" means –

(i) the slip road leading from the westbound

carriageway of the A45 to its roundabout junction with

the A423; or

(ii) the slip road leading from the eastbound carriageway

of the A45 to its roundabout junction with the A423;

"the works period" means the period starting at 2100 hours on Saturday 5

December 2009 and ending when the said works have

been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
  - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform; or
  - (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
