ROAD TRAFFIC

The A458 Trunk Road (Ford, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2009

Made - - - - 21 December 2009

Coming into force - - 28 December 2009

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A458 Trunk Road (“the A458”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road at Ford in the County of Shropshire should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A458 Trunk Road (Ford, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 28 December 2009.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the A458 between points 150 metres west and 460 metres west of its junction with But Lane ;

“the works period” means the period starting at 09.30 hours on Monday 4 January 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding -

(a) 10 miles per hour on a length of the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed; or

(b) 30 miles per hour on a length of the trunk road whilst such traffic signs in relation to that length are not displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any pedestrian to enter or proceed in the footway adjacent to the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of:

- (a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, and
- (b) article 4 shall not apply to any person –
 - (i) engaged in police, fire brigade or ambulance activity, or
 - (ii) engaged in activity connected with the works.
