**The Aylesbury Vale (Parish Electoral Arrangements and  
Electoral Changes) (Amendment) Order 2009**

*Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)*

The Electoral Commission, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1A) of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997(a) (“the 1997 Act”), make the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Aylesbury Vale (Parish Electoral Arrangements and Electoral Changes) (Amendment) Order 2009.

(2) This Order comes into force on the day after that on which it is made.

**Amendment to the 2007 Order**

2.—(1) The Aylesbury Vale (Parish Electoral Arrangements and Electoral Changes) Order 2007(b) is amended by deleting the words “Steeple Claydon ward; Charndon parish” in column (2) of Schedule 4 and inserting the words “Steeple Claydon ward; Calvert Green parish; Charndon parish”.
