**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (Duration of Licence)(No.2) Order 2006 (Amendment) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 6<sup>th</sup> April 2009.

**Amendment to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (Duration of Licence)(No.2) Order 2006**

2.—(1) The Private Security Industry Act 2001 (Duration of Licence)(No.2) Order 2006(3) shall be amended as follows.

(2) Omit article 1(2).
