FUNCTIONS CONFERRED BY MISCELLANEOUS ENACTMENTS

- 5. Functions conferred on the Secretary of State or a local highway authority, as the highway authority for a highway, by or under any of the following provisions of the Public Health Act 1961(1)—
 - (a) section 45 (attachment of street lamps to buildings); and
 - (b) section 81(2) (summary recovery of damages for negligence).

All functions of a Minister of the Crown under the 1961 Act, except functions exercisable as the appropriate authority under section 45 and Schedule 4 in respect of certain descriptions of buildings, so far as exercisable in relation to Wales, were transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/672), article 2 and Schedule 1.
