**The Building (Scotland) Act 2003 (Exemptions  
for Defence and National Security) Order 2009**

**Exemptions for defence and national security**

**3.** The provisions of the 2003 Act and any subordinate legislation made under it shall not apply to—

- (a) a building, or work to or in a building, used or to be used for the purposes of national security;
- (b) work to or in a building, carried out for the purposes of national security; or
- (c) a building, or work to or in a building, occupied for the purposes of—
  - (i) the Secretary of State for Defence;
  - (ii) the Defence Council;
  - (iii) any of the armed forces of the Crown;
  - (iv) any visiting force as defined in the Visiting Forces Act 1952<sup>(1)</sup>; or
  - (v) any international headquarters or defence organisation designated for the purposes of the International Headquarters and Defence Organisations Act 1964<sup>(2)</sup>.
