**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A46 Trunk Road (Leicester to Thorpe on the Hill)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic in Laybys) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - - *1 March 2010*  
*Coming into force* - - - - - *8 March 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, in the Counties of Leicestershire, Nottinghamshire and Lincolnshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Leicester to Thorpe on the Hill) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic in Laybys) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 8 March 2010.

2. In this Order:

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

“the works period” means the period starting at 2000 hours on Wednesday 10 March 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a layby adjacent to the northbound or southbound carriageways of the A46 between its junction with the M1 Junction 21a at Leicester and its roundabout junction with the A1434 and Middle Lane near Thorpe on the Hill.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform, or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
