ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A31 Trunk Road (Ringwood Road, St Leonards)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - *8th March 2010*

Coming into force - - *13th March 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A31 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on lengths of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A31 Trunk Road (Ringwood Road, St Leonards) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 13th March 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A31 Trunk Road (Ringwood Road) in the County of Dorset;

“bus stop area” means an area of carriageway on a side of the trunk road, intended for waiting of buses, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagrams 1025.1 or 1025.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b);

“an A31 bus stop area” means a bus stop area on the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road -

- (i) between points 250 metres east and 350 metres east of Woolsbridge Road roundabout,
- (ii) between points 700 metres east and 850 metres east of Woolsbridge Road roundabout, or
- (iii) between points 500 metres east and 612 metres east of Azalea roundabout.

“works” mean bus stop area improvement work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of –

- (i) 9½ hours starting at 2030 hours on Monday 15th March 2010 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, or
- (ii) 9 hours starting at 2100 hours on Friday 19th March 2010 or on any subsequent Friday,

until 12th September 2011.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in, or wait on, an A31 bus stop area.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
