ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A27 Trunk Road (Upper Brighton Road) (Temporary
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - *15th March 2010*

Coming into force - - *20th March 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted and prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Upper Brighton Road) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 20th March 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A27 Trunk Road (Upper Brighton Road) in the County of West Sussex;

“the length of carriageway” means the westbound carriageway of the trunk road between the centreline of Berriedale Close and a point 160 metres west of that centreline;

“Halewick Lane” means the road known as Halewick Lane at its junction with the trunk road;

“works” means resurfacing work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Wednesday 24th March 2010 or on any subsequent day until 19th September 2011.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to turn right from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road into Halewick Lane.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the length of carriageway while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicated “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6.—(1) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.

(2) Nothing in article 4 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
