ROAD TRAFFIC

The A303 Trunk Road (Weyhill - Andover) (Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2010

Made - - - - *15th March 2010*
Coming into force - - *20th March 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A303 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road and on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A303 Trunk Road (Weyhill - Andover) (Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 20th March 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A303 Trunk Road in the County of Hampshire;

“the length of carriageway” means the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road between a point 300 metres east of Sarson Lane junction and a point 150 metres west of the slip road leading to the A343 (Salisbury Road);

“the slip road” means the road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road at Hundred Acre Interchange (A342/A343);

“works” mean essential carriageway repairs and associated work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 22nd March 2010 or on any subsequent day until 19th September 2011.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding –

- (a) 10 miles per hour on the length of carriageway or the slip road while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on those lengths of road are displayed; or
- (b) 40 miles per hour on the length of carriageway or the slip road while the traffic signs specified in paragraph (a) of this article in relation to those lengths of road are not displayed.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
