**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A14 Trunk Road (Ipswich Western Bypass, Suffolk)  
(Prohibition of Entry) Order 2010**

*Made* 15 March 2010

*Coming into force* 31 March 2010

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Ipswich Western Bypass, Suffolk) (Prohibition of Entry) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 31 March 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the A14” means the A14 Trunk Road, Ipswich Western Bypass, in Suffolk;

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition “carriageway” means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

3. Save as provided in article 4 of this Order, no person shall, except at the direction or with the permission of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to enter the lay-by adjacent to the westbound carriageway of the A14 situated between Junction 54 Sproughton Interchange and Junction 53 Whitehouse Interchange.

4. Nothing in article 3 above shall apply -

(a) so as to prevent a vehicle waiting for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with -

(i) any building operation or demolition,

(ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic,

- (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the trunk road, or
  - (iv) the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal in or near the trunk road of any sewer, main pipe conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984**(a)** on or near the trunk road;
- (b) to a vehicle being used –
- (i) for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes,
  - (ii) in the service of a local authority or of a water or sewerage undertaker within the meaning of the Water Industry Act 1991**(b)**, in pursuance of statutory powers, or
- (c) to a vehicle waiting when a person in control of it is -
- (i) required by law to stop;
  - (ii) obliged to stop in order to avoid an accident; or
  - (iii) prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his or her control.
