## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A446 Trunk Road (M6 Junction 4 to Chester Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made---12 March 2010Coming into force-19 March 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A446 Trunk Road ("the A446") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and on one of those connecting roads in the County of Warwickshire and the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A446 Trunk Road (M6 Junction 4 to Chester Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 19 March 2010.

2. In this Order –

"the trunk road"	means the southbound carriageway of the A446 from its roundabout junction with the M6 Junction 4 to its junction with the A452 Chester Road;
"the link road"	means the link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A446 to its roundabout junction with the A452 and B4438;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 2200 hours on Monday 22 March 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or the link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
