## The M66 Motorway Junction 4 (Southbound Link Road to the M62 Motorway Eastbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M66 Motorway and link roads is satisfied that traffic on one of those link roads in the Borough of Bury in Greater Manchester, should be prohibited because works are proposed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as The M66 Motorway Junction 4 (Southbound Link Road to the M62 Motorway Eastbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 2 May 2010.
- 2. In this Order:

"the link road" means the southbound link road from the M66 Motorway at Junction 4 to the M62 Motorway eastbound carriageway at Junction 18;

"the works period" means 2 periods overnight between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Monday 3 May 2010 and ending on Friday 7 May 2010;

However works may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights, or continue until completed;

"works" means electronic message signs replacement works on the link road;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
