**The M602 Motorway (Junction 3, Westbound Entry
Slip Road)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - - *12 April 2010*

Coming into force - - - - - *10 May 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M602 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the City of Salford in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the M602 Motorway (Junction 3, Westbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 10 May 2010.

2. In this Order;

“motorway” means the M602 Motorway;

“works” means electronic message sign works on the slip road;

“the works period” means a period over two nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Tuesday 11 May 2010 and ending on Tuesday 18 May 2010. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed;

“the slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 3.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle

being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
