**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A45 Trunk Road (Stretton-on-Dunsmore to Thurlaston)  
(Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

*Made - - - -12 March 2010*

*Coming into force - -19 March 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Stretton-on-Dunsmore and Thurlaston in the County of Warwickshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>(a)</sup>, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Stretton-on-Dunsmore to Thurlaston) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 19 March 2010.

2. In this Order –

“Memorial Island” means the circulatory carriageway of the A45 at its roundabout junction with the B4455 at Stretton-on-Dunsmore;

“the trunk road” means the southbound carriageway A45 from Memorial Island to its junction with the slip road leading from the A4071 (Blue Boar junction) near Thurlaston;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 22 March 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on lengths of the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of -

(a) articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle –

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and

(b) article 5 shall not apply to any vehicle –

(i) being used in connection with the said works; or

(ii) proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
