The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the power conferred by section 162 of the Housing Act 2004(a).

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Home Information Pack (Suspension) Order 2010 and comes into force on 21st May 2010.

**Suspension of duties under sections 155 to 159 of the Housing Act 2004**

2. The operation of the duties imposed by sections 155 to 159 of the Housing Act 2004 is suspended.
