**The A12 Trunk Road (Breydon Bridge, Great Yarmouth,
Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Pedestrians)
Order 2010**

Made - - - - 28 May 2010

Coming into force - - 4 June 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road (the A12), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Great Yarmouth in the County of Norfolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Breydon Bridge, Great Yarmouth, Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Pedestrians) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 4 June 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the A12 between its junctions with the A12/A47 Acle New Road Roundabout and the A12/A1243 Gapton Hall/Pasteur Road roundabout, Great Yarmouth;

“a bicycle” means a pedal cycle with fewer than four wheels and not being a mechanically propelled vehicle;

“works” mean routine maintenance work to Breydon Bridge;

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours commencing at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 8 June 2010 or on any subsequent day until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, during a works period, no –

(a) person shall cause or permit any vehicle to, or

(b) pedestrian, or person using a bicycle shall,

enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.

5. Nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle -

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1 (1) and Schedule 1.

- (a) being used in connection with, or for, the said works or for traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform, or
- (d) proceeding to or from properties which are accessible from, and only from, the trunk road.

6. During a works period, the provisions of The A47 Trunk Road (Great Yarmouth Western Bypass) (Prohibition of Right Turns) Order 1988^(a) are hereby suspended.
