The Rice Products from the United States of America (Restriction on First Placing on the Market) (England) (Revocation) Regulations 2010

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(1).

The Secretary of State has been designated for the purposes of that section in relation to measures relating to food (including drink) including the primary production of food and measures relating to feed produced for or fed to food-producing animals(2).

Title and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Rice Products from the United States of America (Restriction on First Placing on the Market) (England) (Revocation) Regulations 2010 and come into force on 16th June 2010.

Revocation

2. The Rice Products from the United States of America (Restriction on First Placing on the Market) (England) Regulations 2008(**3**) are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

1. These Regulations revoke the Rice Products from the United States of America (Restriction on First Placing on the Market) (England) Regulations 2008 (S.I. 2008/622).
