ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 8, Hertfordshire) Slip Roads
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - 18 January 2010
Coming into force - - 25 January 2010

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway (“the A1(M)”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the District of Stevenage in the County of Hertfordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon and nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 8, Hertfordshire) Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 25 January 2010.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, during a period of 9½ hours starting at 19:30 hours on Monday 11 January 2010 or on any subsequent day until the anti-skid surfacing, traffic signal loop cutting, kerb realignment, resiting of lamp columns, signage and road marking works on the A1(M) slip roads and local authority network have been completed, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A1(M) Junction 8 northbound exit slip road leading to the A602 Stevenage Road and the northbound entry and southbound exit slip roads leading from and to the A602 Hitchin Road.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a police officer or traffic officer in uniform.
