**The Competition Act 1998 (Land Agreements  
Exclusion Revocation) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - - *29th June 2010*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *6th April 2011*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 50 of the Competition Act 1998<sup>(1)</sup>, makes the following Order;

In accordance with section 71 of that Act, a draft of this instrument was laid before Parliament and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Competition Act 1998 (Land Agreements Exclusion Revocation) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 6th April 2011.

**Revocation**

2. The Competition Act 1998 (Land Agreements Exclusion and Revocation) Order 2004<sup>(2)</sup> is hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order revokes The Competition Act 1998 (Land Agreements Exclusion and Revocation) Order 2004 ([SI 2004/1260](#)) (“the 2004 Order”). The 2004 Order excludes land agreements, as defined in that Order, from the prohibition on anti-competitive agreements imposed by section 2 of the Competition Act [1998 \(c.41\)](#) (“the Chapter I prohibition”).
