The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Farnborough Airshow) (Amendment) Regulations 2010

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Farnborough Aerodrome by reason of the holding of flying displays that are scheduled to take place between 12th and 26th July 2010.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred under Article 161 of the Air Navigation Order $2009(\mathbf{a})$.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Farnborough Airshow) (Amendment) Regulations 2010 and come into force on 12th July 2010.

2.—(1) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Farnborough Airshow) Regulations 2010(**b**) are amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 2(c), for the words "from the surface", substitute "from 1,500 feet above mean sea level".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Farnborough Airshow) Regulations 2010 (S.I. 2010/1021) in relation to the restriction affecting the airspace specified in regulation 2(c) by altering the base level of the area designated as "2 airspace" from the surface to 1,500 feet above mean sea level.
