**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A64 Trunk Road (Welburn Crossroads to Whitwell-on-the-Hill)  
(Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour and 10 Miles Per Hour Speed  
Restriction) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - - *21 June 2010*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *4 July 2010*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A64 Trunk Road, in the District of Ryedale in the County of North Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be restricted because carriageway resurfacing and road marking renewal works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A64 Trunk Road (Welburn Crossroads to Whitwell-on-the-Hill) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour and 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 4 July 2010.

**2.** In this Order “the A64” means the westbound carriageway of the A64 Trunk Road between a point 100 metres west of the centreline of its junction with Chestnut Avenue (at Welburn Crossroads) and a point 850 metres west of its junction with Cliff Lane (at Whitwell-on-the-Hill), a distance of 2625 metres.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 5 July 2010 or any subsequent Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding:

- (a) 10 miles per hour in the A64 whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that road are displayed; or
- (b) 50 miles per hour in the A64 whilst such traffic signs in relation to that road are not displayed.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform.
