ROAD TRAFFIC

The A595 Trunk Road (Inkerman Terrace to Hensingham Roundabout, Hensingham) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - -

24 June 2010

Coming into force - -

11 July 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A595 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the District of Copeland in the County of Cumbria should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A595 Trunk Road (Inkerman Terrace to Hensingham Roundabout, Hensingham) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 11 July 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A595 Trunk Road;

“the length of carriageway” means a length of the trunk road from a point 100 metres north of the centreline of the junction of the trunk road with the A5094 at Inkerman Terrace to where the centrepoint of the trunk road meets the circulatory carriageway of the A595 Hensingham roundabout;

“the works period” means ten nights between 2000 hours and 0600 hours during a period starting on Monday 12 July 2010 and ending on Sunday 25 July 2010. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such further period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“works” means road marking works on the trunk road;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the length of carriageway at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to overtake a moving vehicle or make a ‘U’ turn in the length of carriageway.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.

And nothing in article 4 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works or by traffic officers.
