## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A1 Trunk Road (Gonerby Moor, Lincolnshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road ("the A1"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Gonerby Moor in the County of Lincolnshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Gonerby Moor, Lincolnshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 5 July 2010.

## **2.** In this Order:

"the roundabout"	means the roundabout junction of Gonerby Lane, the slip roads leading from and to the northbound carriageway of the A1, and the link road leading to Gonerby Moor Roundabout;
"the trunk road"	means the northbound carriageway of the A1 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to the roundabout, to its junction with the entry slip road leading from that roundabout;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 12 July 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
