The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 130 of the Merchant Shipping Act 1995(**a**):

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Ship-to-Ship Transfers) (Amendment) Regulations 2010 and shall come into force on 16th August 2010.

Amendment of the Merchant Shipping (Ship-to-Ship Transfers) Regulations 2010

2.—(1) Regulation 1 of the Merchant Shipping (Ship-to-Ship Transfers) Regulations 2010(**b**) is amended as follows.

(2) In paragraph (2) for "1st April 2011" substitute "1st October 2011".

(3) In paragraph (3) for "1st October 2010" substitute "1st April 2011".

(4) In paragraph (3)(a) for "1st April 2011" substitute "1st October 2011".

(5) In paragraph (4) for "1st October 2010" substitute "1st April 2011".
