ROAD TRAFFIC

The A49 Trunk Road (Dorrington, Shropshire) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010

Made - - - - 26 July 2010

Coming into force - - 2 August 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road (“the A49”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road at Dorrington in the County of Shropshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A49 Trunk Road (Dorrington, Shropshire) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 2 August 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means A49 from a point 200 metres north of its junction with Limes Paddock for a distance of 450 metres in a northerly direction;

“the works period” means the period starting at 2000 hours on Monday 9 August 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on a length of the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
