ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A52 Trunk Road (Radcliffe on Trent, Nottinghamshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - 26 July 2010

Coming into force - - 2 August 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road (“the A52”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Radcliffe on Trent in the County of Nottinghamshire should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road (Radcliffe on Trent, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 2 August 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the A52 Grantham Road at Radcliffe on Trent in the County of Nottinghamshire;

“a pedal cycle” has the meaning given in regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (b)

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the period starting at 06.00 hours on Sunday 8 August 2010 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this Order, cause or permit any vehicle –

- (i) to make a right turn from the trunk road into Nottingham Road; or
- (ii) to make a left turn from the trunk road into Nottingham Road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of –

a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable , and

b) article 3 (ii) shall not apply to a pedal cycle.
