Amendment of the Data Protection Act 1998

6. In section 69(1)(d) of the Data Protection Act 1998⁽¹⁾ (meaning of “health professional”), for “a registered pharmacist or registered pharmacy technician within the meaning of the Pharmacists and Pharmacy Technicians Order 2007” substitute “a registered pharmacist or a registered pharmacy technician within the meaning of article 3(1) of the Pharmacy Order 2010”.
