Miscellaneous Provisions

Consideration of suitability

21. References in Part 2 of the 2007 Act to a person (“A”) considering an individual’s suitability to do, or to be offered or supplied for, any type of regulated work include a reference to A considering the individual’s suitability to be registered or licensed under Part V (driving instruction) of the Road Traffic Act 1988⁽¹⁾.

22. References in Part 2 of the 2007 Act to a person (“A”) considering an individual’s suitability to do, or to be offered or supplied for, any type of regulated work include a reference to A considering the individual’s suitability to be registered in the register established and maintained under article 19 of the Pharmacy Order 2010⁽²⁾.

Amendment of the General Pharmaceutical Council (Registration Rules) Order of Council 2010

23.—(1) The General Pharmaceutical Council (Registration Rules) Order of Council 2010⁽³⁾ is amended as follows.

(2) In rule 10 (entry in the Register) of the Schedule—

(a) in paragraph (5)—

(i) in sub-paragraph (a), omit “or the Scottish Ministers”;

(ii) at the end of sub-paragraph (e), omit “and”;

(iii) at the end of sub-paragraph (f) insert—

“; and

(g) a disclosure request and any existing disclosure record”; and

(b) after paragraph (12), substitute—

“(12) For the purposes of this rule—

“attesting State” means the relevant European State in which a person applying for entry in Part 1 or Part 2 of the Register obtained their qualification as a pharmacist or, as the case may be, a pharmacy technician and, if different, the relevant European State from which that person comes to Great Britain; and
