**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A5 Trunk Road (Paulerspury to Towcester) (Temporary  
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - 8 February 2010

*Coming into force* - - 15 February 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road between Paulerspury and Towcester in the County of Northamptonshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A5 Trunk Road (Paulerspury to Towcester) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 15 February 2010.

2. In this Order –

| “the first length trunk road”  | means the A5 from a point 45 metres south of its junction with Longcroft Lane to a point 140 metres north of its junction with Tew’s End Lane, near Paulerspury;  |
| “the second length trunk road” | means the A5 between its junction with Marlow Road and its junction with Vernon Road, Towcester;  |
| “layby”                        | means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the sign is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right; |

"the works period" means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Tuesday 16 February 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding –

- (a) 40 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road; and
- (b) 10 miles per hour on lengths of the second length of trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A5 approximately 112 metres north of its junction with Marlow Road, Towcester.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of:

- (a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -
  - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or
  - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform; and
- (b) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
