The Animal Gatherings Order 2010

The use of premises for animal gatherings

5.—(1) No person may use any premises for an animal gathering unless those premises are licensed for that purpose by a veterinary inspector.

(2) An application for a licence must be in writing.

(3) A licence must include—

- (a) the name of the licensee;
- (b) the premises on which the animal gathering may take place; and
- (c) particulars that identify the animal area.
