ROAD TRAFFIC

The M60 Motorway (Junction 27, Clockwise Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

 Made
 4 January 2010

 Coming into force
 31 January 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M60 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the District of Stockport in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order.

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the M60 Motorway (Junction 27, Clockwise Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 31 January 2010.
- 2. In this Order;

"motorway" means the M60 Motorway;

"works" means works to install a new vehicle restraint system on the slip road;

"the works period" means periods overnight between 2200 hours and 0500 hours starting on Monday 1 February 2010 and ending on Saturday 27 February 2010. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed;

"the slip road" means the entry slip road leading to the clockwise carriageway of the motorway at Junction 27.

- 3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.
- 4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle

being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services,
vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle
proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer or traffic officer
in uniform.
