WILDLIFE, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (Variation of Schedule 9) (England and Wales) Order 2010

The Secretary of State, in relation to England, and the Welsh Ministers, in relation to Wales, make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 22(5) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981⁽¹⁾.

In accordance with the requirements of section 26(4)(2) of that Act, the Secretary of State and the Welsh Ministers—

- (a) have given any local authority affected and any other person affected an opportunity to submit objections or representations with respect to the subject matter of this Order; and
- (b) have consulted with the Joint Nature Conservation Committee, being the advisory body they considered was best able to advise them as to whether this Order should be made.
